### INSTALLATION KIT CONTENTS:

- CARGO LINER
- 9 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener
  - LIFTGATE COVER
- 21 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

# VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION

To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fasteners stick to the plastic trim, you MUST CLEAN all grime from the plastic and REMOVE all SILICONE applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this, please:

- 1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover, and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- 2. Using a separate clean, dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 and 2 if necessary.) Extra tabs have been provided.
- 3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.





### Please note: not all of the photographs are specific to your vehicle.

#### **STEP 1. PREPARATIONS**

- Remove the cargo cover. It can be replaced later.
- Set the floor level to fit the specifications of your order.
- Put the headrests in their highest position. (Image A)



### STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

• Place the Cargo liner in the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the underside attach directly to the carpet. (Image B)



### STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the Cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.

### **REAR PLUS VERSIONS**

You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper part of the rear seats. (*Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo.*)





### STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

• The side panels of the Cargo liner are attached directly to the carpeted area on the sides of the cargo area. Align the hook fasteners along the top and back edge of the Cargo liner side panel with the edges of the carpeted area. (Image E)



### STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK

Stick the 9 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener to the plastic panel located at the liftgate end of the side of the cargo area, aligned with the hook fastener on the back of the Cargo liner. (Image F & G) Repeat on the opposite side.





## **OPTIONAL EXTRAS**

Please note: not all of the photographs are specific to your vehicle.

### STEP 5A LIFTGATE COVER

• Line up each of the 2 part Liftgate Cover with the rear doors and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 1)



Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



### STEP 5B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install the Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 2)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

### STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection for the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option.

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus / Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection for the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It offers no protection to the rear doors.
- Attach the Cargo Liner Extension to the main Cargo liner. (Image 3)





## Please note: Bumper Flap and Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

### STEP 5D. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

• If you frequently remove/install your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will "fluff" up - we offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit. These tabs are placed between the Cargo liner and the cargo area carpet.(Image 4 & 5)
