INSTALLATION KIT CONTENTS:

CARGO LINER
2500mm cut length of 30mm wide loop
fastener.
Minimum of 8 self-adhesive loop fastener tabs

LIFTGATE COVER
Minimum of 19 self-adhesive loop fastener
tabs

PREPARATION

- Remove the retractable cargo cover; it may be replaced later.
- Unfold the Hatchbag and place in the vehicle so that the base fits snugly in position. The panel with the Hatchbag label sits against the back of the rear seat.

VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION

To ensure a good bond, when using the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener to attach the cargo liner to the plastic / metal trim (**Not** the carpet); it is most important to remove silicone film from the vehicle trim. Silicone is applied during manufacture and can also be found in many detailing products. It is **highly likely there will be a build-up of silicone**. Before applying any self-adhesive fastener pads, the surface **MUST be thoroughly** cleaned using a silicone remover. (The fasteners cannot be used once it has been in contact with silicone). We recommend Intensive Tar Remover made by AutoGlym. Wipe off thoroughly **any residue with a separate clean dry cloth.**

Unfortunately, we are unable to supply this product, as it cannot be transported via our postal carrier.

NOTE: the adhesive takes 24hrs to reach full adhesion, do not disturb during.





INSTALLING

BASE

- Position the base of the liner snugly into place.
- Hook fasteners attach directly to the carpet.



FRONT

- Hook & loop fastener straps align to headrests.
- Pass around each post and fasten close back onto themselves.

REAR PLUS VERSIONS

 YOU MUST UNFASTEN THE HOOK & LOOP FASTENER AND THE HEADREST STRAPS BEFORE YOU FOLD THE UPPER PARTS OF THE REAR SEATS. Please refer to REAR PLUS options on website to see detailed photos.

"Easy fold-down" rear seatback.

The handles in the cargo area are **covered** by the liner.

Only a **gentle pull** on these handles is required to operate the auto-folding. You can access the handles, (once you have unfastened the headrest straps) by peeling the rear corners away from the fastener, but they **will not be exposed for your dog's roving paws!!!!!**





SIDES

• Carefully position the side panels snugly into place. Use both the small tabs and long length of the self-adhesive loop fasteners to attach the side to the plastic trim.



REAR

- Carefully position the back panel snugly into place.
 Use the remaining length of self-adhesive loop fastener to attach the back to the plastic trim.
- Pull back the rubber seal so that you can attach the full width of the fastener. You will need to snip the fastener strip to get it to lie flat.
- The bound edge of the liner can be tucked under the rubber seal when fastening to the hook fastener.





Please note: Photos are not specific to your vehicle.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the Liftgate Cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 1)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



BUMPER FLAP

- Install the Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 2)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.



CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection for the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option.

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus / Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection for the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- The max. width is 148cm.
- It offers no protection to the rear doors.
- Attach the Cargo Liner Extension to the main Cargo liner.
