PACKAGING REQUIREMENTS.

CARGO LINER

- **14x** self-Adhesive loop fastener tabs
- **2x 730mm** 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener

LIFTGATE COVER

- **20x tabs** self-adhesive loop fastener

VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from the plastic from **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and valeting.

To do this please:

1. Use a silicone remover, such as Auto-Glym Intensive Tar Remover and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
2. Using a separate clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) Extra tabs have been provided.
3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

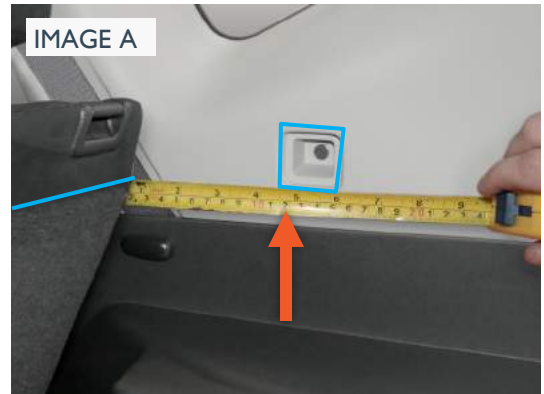
**The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.*

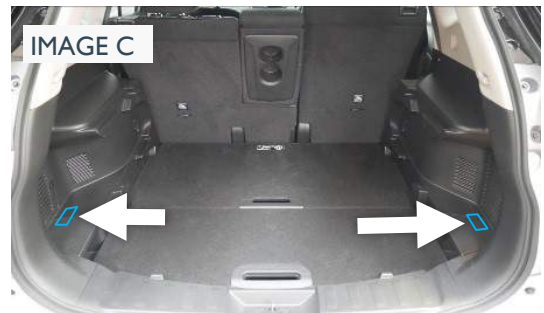
STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Please remove the cargo cover, it may be replaced once the Cargo liner is fitted.
- Please recline your seat so that it is 11 cm away from the load cover slot **Image A**.
- Set the floor to the position as specified during your order.



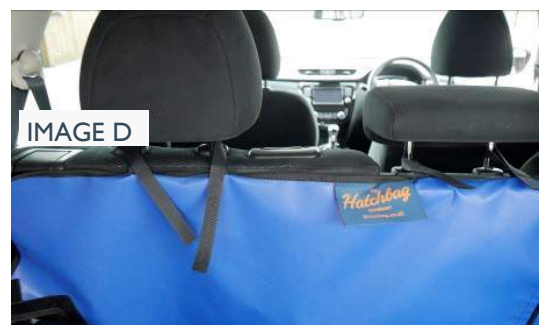
STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

- Place the Cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so that it fits snugly against the edges. (**Image B**)
- Attach one self-adhesive loop fastener strip on the plastic base of the recess on either side of the cargo area. Align these with the hook fastener on the back side of the Cargo liner base and attach. (**Image C**)



STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- - **PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY** - Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (**Image D**)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (**Image E**). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the Cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.



REAR PLUS VERSIONS

You **MUST** unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper parts of the rear seats. (*Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo*)

STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES & BACK

- Attach the 710mm long self-adhesive loop fastener strips below the joint of the 2 plastic panels on either side of the cargo area. (Image F) (In the photo the top panel is white and the bottom is black.)
- Attach the hook fastener located at the back of the sides of the liner on the previously attached loop fastener strips.
- Attach 3 self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to both side panels by the liftgate. Make sure the loop fastener is in line with the hook fastener on the back of the Cargo liner as shown in Image G.
- Attach a further 3 loop fastener tabs on each side of the rear panel, aligned with the hook fastener on the back of the Cargo liner's base as shown in Image H.



OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Please note: the following photos are not specific to your vehicle

STEP 5A. TAILGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



STEP 5B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option. (Image 3)

- The Cargo Line Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors



The Bumper Flap and the Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.
