### VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fasteners sticks to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from the plastic and **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and detailing.

#### To do this please:

1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
2. Using a **separate** clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if it doesn't stick)
3. Attach the fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.



*\*The fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available from our website.*

## STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Ensure if you have a variable floor that your floor is set to the level to suit your order. Refer to the VI ( Vehicle identification sheet)

## STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

- Place the cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the back side attach directly to the carpet. (Image A)



## STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- - **PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY** - Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and seat panel. (Image B)
- Starting with the center headrest for HR3 version or an outer headrest for HR2 version, loop the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image C). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the Hatchbag too far up. Repeat the procedure with the other headrests.
- - **HR2 VERSION ONLY** - Identify the two liner fasteners to attach the liner to the carpeted section of the back seats. Attach 113 tabs to the carpet first, and then the liner fasteners attach to these. (Image D).
- PLEASE NOTE; To recline the seat /remove the liner, peel it away from the 113 tabs leaving them in place. This will reduce the carpet from fluffing up.



## REAR PLUS VERSIONS

You **MUST** unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper part of the rear seats. (Please refer to **REAR PLUS / SPLIT** options on website to see detailed photo)

## STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

- Position the front of the side snugly into position. The hook fasteners on the back side of the liner attach directly to the carpet.  
(LOW FLOOR Image E / RAISED FLOOR Image F)
- Repeat on opposite side.



## INSTALLING THE BACK



Stick the self-adhesive tabs onto the plastic panel located at the liftgate end of the side and in line with the hook fasteners located at the back side of the cargo liner. (image G)  
Repeat on opposite side.

- Stick one self-adhesive fastener tab on the center inside of the back panel in line with the hook fastener located on the back panel of the cargo liner. (arrow - Image G)





## OPTIONAL EXTRAS

*Please note: the following photos are not specific to your vehicle*

### STEP 5A. BUMPER FLAP

- Install Cargo Liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the cargo liner. (Image 1)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.



### STEP 5B. LIFTGATE COVER (Image 2)

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean only the areas where the self-adhesive fastener tabs will be stuck to the plastic.
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.
- The remaining fasteners attach directly to the carpet.



### STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option. (Image 3)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended cargo area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors



### STEP 5D. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

- If you frequently remove/install your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will “fluff” up - we offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit. (Image 4+5)

The Frequent Use Installation Kit is available from our online store. Simply add it to your order from the Store. The kit can also be ordered at a later date.
