PACKAGING REQUIREMENTS.

- 2 x 225 mm 30mm wide selfadhesive loop fastener
- 16 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from the plastic and **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this please:

- 1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- 2. Using a separate clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one selfadhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) Extra tabs have been provided.
- 3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.



*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.





STEP I. PREPARATIONS

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Set the rear seat incline to the most upright, it can be altered later to suit.

STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

• Place the cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The loop fasteners on the back side attach directly to the carpet. (Image A)



STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image B)
- Starting with the middle headrest, loop the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image C). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.



You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper parts of the rear seats. (Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo)





STEP 4. INSTALLING THE BACK & SIDES

- Stick the self adhesive loop fastener tabs on the metal / plastic liftgate end of the cargo liner and aligned with the hook fastener on the back side of the Cargo liner. (Image D & E) One tab must follow the angle of the carpet rather than the angle it is on the cargp liner, see the orange arrow. Repeat on opposite side.
- Stick the 225mm self adhesive loop fastener strip on the plastic as indicated by the yellow highlight (Image E) Repeat on opposite side.
- Atach the sides.
- Note: The hook fastener on the top edge of the sides of the cargo liner attach directly to the carpet along the top edge of the carpeted sides of the cargo area. (see white arrows in Image F)







STEP 5. REAR SEAT INCLINE

- Should you wish to recline the seats, the two outer wings will fold back into the cargo area. (Image G)
- You have the option to re-adjust the headrest straps now.



OPTIONAL EXTRAS

STEP 5A. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 1)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



STEP 5B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner.

 (Image 2)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

STEP 5D. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased in a REAR PLUS option. (Image 3)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors.



The Bumper Flap and the Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

STEP 5E. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

If you frequently remove/install your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle please note that the carpet will "fluff" up. We offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit (Image 4+5)

The Frequent Use Installation Kit is available to buy from our store. Simply add it to your order from the store. These can also be ordered at a later date.
