#### **INSTALLATION KIT CONTENTS:**



- 2 x 430 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 2 x 560 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener

## VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you MUST CLEAN all grime from the plastic and REMOVE all SILICONE applied during manufacture and detailing.

#### To do this please:

- 1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover, and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- 2. Using a separate clean, dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 and 2 if necessary.) Extra tabs have been provided.
- 3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.

#### STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Put the headrests in their highest position.
  (Image A)



#### STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

 Place the cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the underside attach directly to the carpet. (Image B)




#### STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts.
  (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.



You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper part of the rear seats. (Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo.)

#### STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

### (REF 121 FASTENER TABS)

- Insert 4 ref:121 fastener tabs on each side of the Liftgate end of the cargo. To do this peel back the rubber and slot the plastic end of the fastener tabs into the void behind the carpeted panel of the cargo area. (Image E - this photo is non-specific to your car)
- Slide these fastener tabs up or down so that they align with the hook fastener welded onto the rear sides of the cargo liner. (Image F - see blue highlights)
- On both sides of the cargo stick the following loop fasteners in line with the hook fasteners sewn & welded on the reverse side of the cargo liner as highlighted on Image G.
  - Green 560 mm loop fastener
  - Orange 6 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener
- If necessary snip the self-adhesive fastener strips at the corners to ease around the curves.
- Fasten the hook fastener sewn onto the top and back edge on both sides of the cargo liner directly onto the previously attached loop fasteners. (Image H)

#### STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK

Stick the 2 x 430mm to the plastic panel located at the Liftgate end of the side of the cargo area, aligned with the hook fastener on the back of the cargo liner. (Image I - highlighted in orange)

### **OPTIONAL EXTRAS**

Please note: not all of the photographs are specific to your vehicle.

## STEP 6A. LIFTGATE COVER



- Line up the Liftgate cover with the Liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 1)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.

#### STEP 6B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install the cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the cargo liner. (Image 2)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the Liftgate.





#### STEP 6C, CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo liner extension provides protection for the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option.

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus version liner Image 3.
- It offers additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It will offer no protection to the rear doors

Please Note: the Bumper Flap & the Cargo liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.
