### Packaging requirements:

#### ☐ CARGO LINER

- 2 x 330mm <u>50</u>mm wide, self-adhesive loop fastener
- 2 x 880mm 30mm wide, s-a. loop fastener
- 2 x 440mm 30mm wide, s-a. loop fastener
- 2 x 120mm 30mm wide, s-a. loop fastener
- 2 x 340mm 30mm wide, s-a. loop fastener
- 2 x Frequent use tabs (ref.113)
- 2 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener



- 17 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener
- 1 x 490mm 30mm wide s-a. loop fastener

## VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you MUST CLEAN all grime from the plastic and REMOVE all the SILICONE applied during manufacture and detailing.

#### To do this please:

- 1. Use a silicone remover, such as 'Auto-Glym Intensive Tar Remover' and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- Using a separate clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) Extra tabs have been provided.
- 3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once it has been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.

#### **STEP 1. INSTALLING THE BASE**

#### 6 & 7 SEATER ONLY

 Loop the elastic straps sewn to the cargo liner base around the head rests of the folded 3rd row seats. (image A)



#### **ALL MODELS**

 Attach the two frequent use tabs on both back corners of the floor. (highlighted in blue image B)





 Place the Cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners welded to the reverse face fix directly to the carpet. (image C)



#### **STEP 2. INSTALLING THE FRONT**

Fasten the straps around headrests. (image
 D). Make sure to hold the front part of the
 base in position as not to pull the Cargo liner
 too far up. Repeat on the other two headrest.

You MUST unfasten the headrest straps before you recline the rear seat uppers. ('Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo')



#### **STEP 3. INSTALLING THE SIDES**





Attach the loop fastener strips to both sides plastic panels as showed on images E & F (Near side) following the color code on first page packaging requirements.




Stick the two self-adhesive loop fastener tabs on near side plastic panel (highlighted in yellow image E & image F) in line with the hook fastener tabs welded on the reverse side of the Cargo liner near side.

- Snip the self-adhesive fastener strips in the corners to ease around the bend. (highlighted in white and pink—images E & G)
- Fasten the hook fastener sewn and welded on the reverse side of the boot liner to the previously attached fasteners. (image H)









#### **STEP 4.** ACCES TO UNDERFLOOR STORAGE

- Unfasten the top hook-loop fastener as shown on image I
- Pull the handle up (image J)





### **OPTIONAL EXTRAS**

Please note not all of the photographs are specific to your vehicle

#### **STEP 5A. HEADREST COVER**

Only available for 5 & 7 seater.

- The Headrest cover is designed to protect the top of your rear seat giving additional protection from drooling dogs etc. (Image 1)
- Lower the headrests.
- Attach the Headrest cover to the loop fastener strip on the Cargo liner just below the top of the rear seats. (Image 2)
- Rear Plus / Split Cargo Liners ONLY
   The additional rectangle shaped section/s offer protection should you fold the seats (Image 3)




• Line up the Liftgate Cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)

 Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.

#### STEP 5C. BUMPER FLAP

- Install the Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.











## **OPTIONAL EXTRAS page 2**

Please note the following photos are not specific to your vehicle

#### **STEP 5D.** CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased in a REAR PLUS option. (Image 6 & 7)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors
- Attach the floor extension to the main cargo liner (Image 6)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together. (White arrows Image 7)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Blue arrow - Image 7)
- Fasten the hook fastener tab under the bootliner side to the loop fastener previously attached (Green arrow - Image 7)







The Bumper Flap and the Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

#### **STEP 5E.** FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

 If you frequently remove/fit your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle please note that the carpet will "fluff" up. We offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit. (Image 5 & 6)
