# Packaging requirements:

## CARGO LINER

2 x 430 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener

# LIFTGATE COVER

22 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

# L VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION

To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you MUST CLEAN all grime from the plastic and REMOVE all SILICONE applied during manufacture and detailing.

#### To do this please:

- Use a silicone remover, such as 'AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover' and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- Using a separate clean, dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) A couple of spares have been provided.
- Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.





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# **STEP 1. PREPARATIONS**

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Set the seats to the fully reclined position



## STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

 Place the Cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the back side attach directly to the carpet. (Image B)



## STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts.
   (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the Cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.



You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners +
the headrest straps before you recline the upper
part of the rear seats. (Please refer to REAR
PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed
photo)





# STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

- Attach the hook fastener on the top and rear edge of the Cargo liner sides directly to the outer edges of the carpeted sides of the cargo area. (Image E)
- Push Cargo liner behind the net and secure to the carpet using the hook fastener on back of the Cargo liner. (Image F)





# STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK

 Stick the 430mm long loop fastener (highlighted in blue) on the chrome panel located on either side of the lock at the liftgate end of the cargo area. Attach the Cargo liner to it using the hook fastener on the liner. (Image G)

# STEP 5A. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.

## STEP 5B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install the cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip that located at the base of the cargo liner. (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

#### STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection for the rear seats when purchased in conjunction with a REAR PLUS option. (image 3 & 4)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It will offer no full protection to the rear doors
- Attach the cargo liner extension to the main cargo liner (Image 3)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together (Orange arrows - Image 4)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Blue arrows - Image 4)

The Bumper Flap and Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a late date.

# STEP 5D. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

 If you frequently remove/install your cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will "fluff" up – we offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit (image 5+6)
