Packaging requirements:

CARGO LINER

- **2 x 450mm** 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- **2 x 370mm** 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- **2 x 250mm** 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- **3 x tabs** self-adhesive loop fastener

LIFTGATE COVER

- **17 x tabs** self-adhesive loop fastener
- **2 x 580mm** 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener



VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from plastic and **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this please:

1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover' and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
2. Using a separate clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) Extra tabs have been provided.
3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

**The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.*



STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.

STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

- Place the Cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the back side of the liner attach directly to the carpet. (Image A)
- Stick the 2 x 250mm self-adhesive loop fastener (highlighted in yellow – Image B) in line with the hook on the back side of liner.



STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- - PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY - fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the straps around headrest. (image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position as not to pull the cargo liner too far up. Repeat on the other two headrest.



REAR PLUS VERSIONS

You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners + the headrest straps before you recline the rear seat uppers. ('Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo')

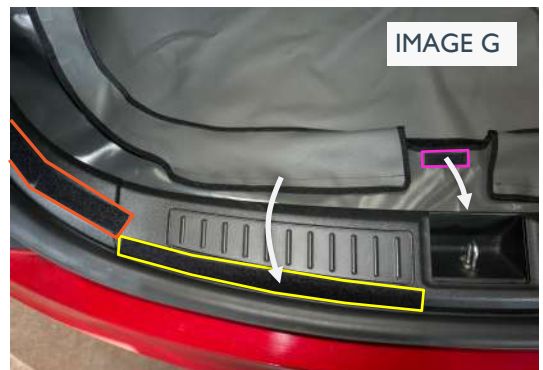
STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

- Attach the hook fastener on the top edge of the side of the Cargo liner directly on the top edge of the carpeted sides of the cargo area. (Image E)
- On both sides make sure to push the liner into the pocket (blue arrow - Image F)
- Stick on each side of the cargo area one *self adhesive loop fastener tab* (highlighted in green - Image F) and one *450mm self-adhesive loop fastener strip* (highlighted in orange - Image F) Snip the self-adhesive fastener strips in the corners to ease around the curve.
- Attach the Cargo liner to it using the hook fastener on the liner.



STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK

- Stick the *420mm self-adhesive loop fastener* (highlighted in yellow - Image G) and one *self adhesive loop fastener tab* (highlighted in pink - Image G)
- Attach the Cargo liner to them using the hook fastener on the back side of the Cargo liner.



OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Please note: the following photos are not specific to your vehicle

STEP 5A. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 1)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



STEP 5B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the cargo liner. (Image 2)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option. (Image 3 & 4)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors
- Attach the floor extension to the main liner (Image 3)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together . (Orange arrows - Image 4)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Blue arrows—Image 4)

The Bumper Flap and the Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

STEP 5D. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

- If you frequently remove/install your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle please, note that the carpet will “fluff” up. We offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit (Image 5 & 6)

The Frequent Use Installation Kit is available to buy from our online store. Simply add it to your order from the store. The kits can also be ordered at a later date.
