

# Porsche Cayenne (not Coupé) - 2018 Present

## INSTALLATION KIT CONTENTS :

CARGO LINER

- 7 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

LIFTGATE COVER

- 18 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener



SH1- Rear Plus with Seat Split cargo liner prepped for a cargo liner extension and bumper flap.



## VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from the plastic and **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this please:

1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover, and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
2. Using a separate clean, dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 and 2 if necessary.) Extra tabs have been provided.
3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

*\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.*

## STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Put the headrest in it's highest position. (Image A)



## STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

- Place the cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the underside attach directly to the carpet. (Image B)



## STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- **PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY** - Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.



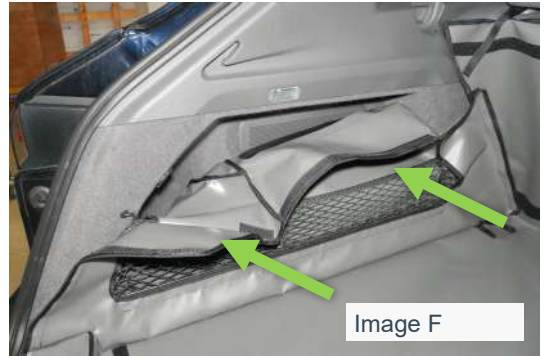
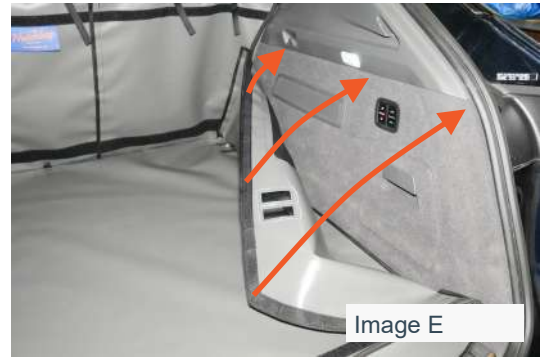
## REAR PLUS VERSIONS

You **MUST** unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper part of the rear seats. (Please refer to **REAR PLUS / SPLIT** options on website to see detailed photo.)



## STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

- The side panels of the cargo liner are attached directly to the carpeted area on the sides of the cargo. Align the hook fasteners along the top and back edge of the cargo liner side panel with the edges of the carpeted area. (Image E ,F & G)
- Push the liner into the pocket (green arrow - image F)



## STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK

- Stick self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to the panel located on either side of the lock at the Liftgate end of the cargo area. Attach the cargo liner to it using the hook fastener on the liner. (Highlighted in Orange Image H)
- Stick 1 self-adhesive fastener tab to the inside center of the back panel, aligned with the hook fastener on the back panel of the cargo liner. (Highlighted in Yellow - Image H)



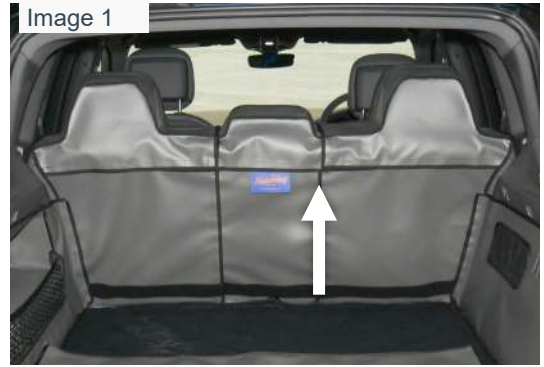


# OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Please note: not all of the photographs are specific to your vehicle.

## STEP 5A. HEADREST COVER

- The Headrest cover is designed to protect the top of your rear seat giving additional protection from drooling dogs etc. (Image 1)
- Lower the headrests.
- Attach the Headrest cover to the loop fastener strip on the Cargo liner just below the top of the rear seats. (Image 2)
- Rear Plus / Split Cargo Liners ONLY  
The additional rectangle shaped section/s offer protection should you fold the seats (Image 3)



## STEP 5B. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the Liftgate Cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)



Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.

## STEP 5C. BUMPER FLAP

- Install the Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.



## OPTIONAL EXTRAS PAGE 2

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### STEP 6D. CARGOLINER EXTENSION

The Cargo liner extension provides superior protection for the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option.

- The Cargo liner extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection for the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors
- Attach the Cargo liner extension to the main cargo liner (Image 6)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together (Orange arrows - Image 7)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around the headrest posts. (Blue arrows - Image 7)
- Attach the hook fastener tab welded on the back corner of the cargo liner extension to the carpet on the cargo side (Green arrow - Image 8)
- Repeat on opposite side

**Please Note: the the Bumper Flap & the Cargoliner Extension cannot be added at a later date.**

### STEP 6E. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

- If you frequently remove/install your cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will “fluff” up – we offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit . These tabs are placed between the cargo liner and the cargo carpet.(Image 9 & 10)

The Frequent Use installation Kit is an accessory available to purchase from our on-line store.
