### PACKAGING REQUIREMENTS:

#### CARGO LINER

- 2 x 360 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 2 x 520 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 1 x 680 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 1 x 590 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 2 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

#### LIFTGATE COVER

- 22 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

### VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from the plastic and **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this please:

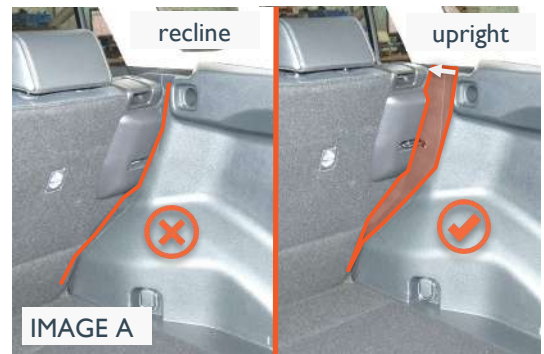
1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
2. Using a separate clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) Extra tabs have been provided.
3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

*\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.*



## STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Set the seat incline to the upright position. It may be repositioned later. (Image A)
- Put the headrests in their highest position.



## STEP 2. FITTING THE BASE

- Place the Cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the back side of the liner attach directly to the carpet. (image B)



## STEP 3. FITTING THE FRONT

- - PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY - Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.




### REAR PLUS VERSIONS

You **MUST** unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper parts of the rear seats. (Please refer to **REAR PLUS / SPLIT** options on website to see detailed photo)



## STEP 4. FITTING THE SIDES & BACK

- On both sides of the cargo area stick the following loop fasteners, aligned with the hook fasteners on the back side of the liner as highlighted on **image E, F & G**:  



● Pink 680 mm loop fastener

● Blue 590 mm loop fastener

● Orange 520 mm loop fastener

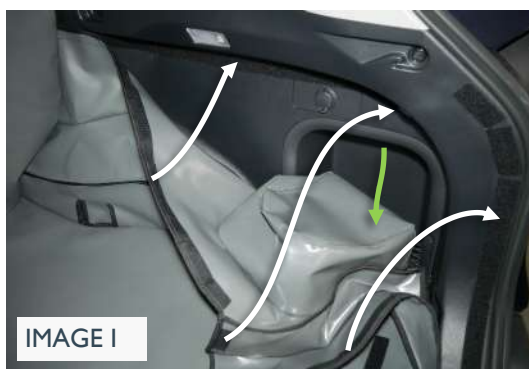
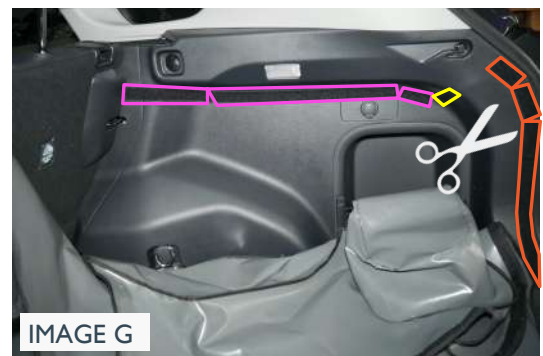
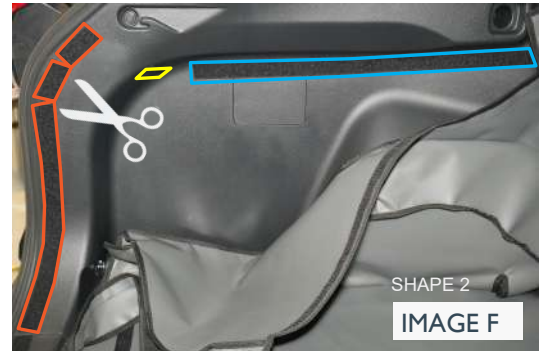
● Yellow Self adhesive loop fastener tabs

- Snip the edges of the fastener to ease around the curves if necessary.

- Stick the *360mm self-adhesive loop fastener* on the plastic panel located on either side of the lock at the liftgate end of the cargo area, aligned with the hook fasteners on the back side of the Cargo liner. (**Image H**).  


● Green 360 mm loop fastener

- Attach the hook fastener on the top and back edge on both sides of the liner directly on the loop fasteners fixed in place previously. (**Image I & J**)



## OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Please note the following photos are non-specific to your vehicle

### STEP 5A. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 1)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



### STEP 5B. BUMPER FLAP

- Install Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 2)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

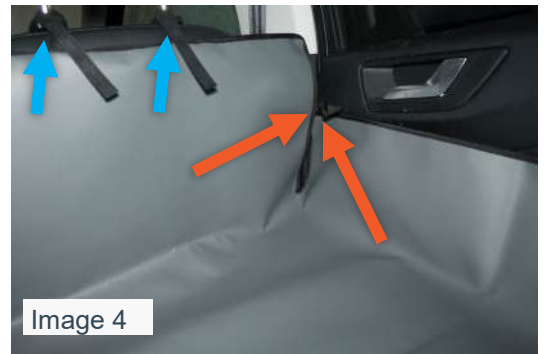
## OPTIONAL EXTRAS PAGE 2

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### STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased in conjunction with a REAR PLUS option. (Image 3 & 4)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors
- Attach the floor extension to the main liner (Image 3)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together (Orange arrows - Image 4)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Blue arrows - Image 4)



**The Bumper Flap and the cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.**
