#### INSTALLATION KIT CONTENTS :

- CARGO LINER
- 2 x 400 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 16 x frequent use installation tabs (Ref 113) self-adhesive loop fastener
  - LIFTGATE COVER
  - 16 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you MUST CLEAN all grime from the plastic and REMOVE all SILICONE applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this please:

- 1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover, and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- 2. Using a separate clean, dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 and 2 if necessary.) Extra tabs have been provided.
- 3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

\*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.

#### **STEP 1. PREPARATIONS**

- Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.
- Put the central headrest in its highest position. (Image A)




#### STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

- Place the cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it installs snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the underside attach directly to the carpet. (Image B)
- Starting in the left-hand corner behind the rear seats, carefully peel back the base to expose the hook fastener and fasten one ref:113 to the exposed carpet, aligned with where the hook fastener is attached. (Image C)
- Repeat for all 8 hook fasteners on the base panel.

NOTE: When temporarily removing the cargo liner, peel the liner away from the ref:113 leaving it attached to the carpet. This will prevent the carpet fibers from fluffing up, reducing the functionality of the fasteners.






#### STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image D)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image E).
- Loop the elastic fastener straps around both headrests. (Image E). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the cargo liner too far up.
- REAR PLUS VERSIONS


You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper part of the rear seats. (*Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo.*)





#### STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

- The side panels of the cargo liner are attached directly to the carpeted area on the sides of the cargo. Align the hook fasteners along the top edge of the cargo liner side panel with the edges of the carpeted area. (Image F)
- For a more secure install, we have included 8 frequent use installation tabs *(ref. 113)* that have hook fastener on one side and loop on the other. These are placed between the carpeted sides of the cargo area and the cargo liner. We recommend using these on the green highlighted area of the cargo area (green arrow - Image F)




#### STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK



Stick the (400mm fastener) to the panel located on either side of the lock at the liftgate end of the cargo area. Snip the self-adhesive fastener strips at the corners to ease around the curve.

• Attach the cargo liner to it using the hook fastener on the liner. (Image G)



### **OPTIONAL EXTRAS**

#### STEP 6A. SEAT FLAP & TAILORED SEAT FLAP

- The <u>Headrest cover</u> is designed to protect the top of your rear seat giving additional protection from drooling dogs etc. (Image 1)
- Lower the headrests
- Attach the Headrest Cover to the loop fastener strip on the Cargo liner just below the top of the rear seats. (Image 2)
- <u>Rear Plus / Split Cargo Liners ONLY</u>
  The additional rectangle shaped section/s offer
  protection should you fold the seats (Image 3)

### STEP 6B. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.



- Install the cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the cargo liner. (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

#### STEP 6D. CARGOLINER EXTENSION

The Cargo liner extension provides superior protection for the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option.

- The Cargo liner extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection for the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors
- Attach the Cargo liner extension to the main cargo liner (Image 6)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together (Orange arrows - Image 7)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around the headrest posts. (Blue arrows Image 7)
- Fasten ties to the corresponding rear seat striker loop (Green arrow Image 8)
- Repeat on opposite side

Please Note: the Seat Flap, the Bumper Flap & the Cargo liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

#### STEP 6E. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

• If you frequently remove/install your cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will "fluff" up – we offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit . These tabs are placed between the cargo liner and the cargo area carpet.(Image 9 & 10)

The Frequent Use Kit is an accessory available to purchase from our on-line store.
