INSTALLATION KIT CONTENTS:

CARGO LINER

- 4 x 400 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 2 x 600 mm 30mm wide self-adhesive loop fastener
- 1 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fasteners stick to the plastic trim, you MUST CLEAN all grime from the plastic and REMOVE all SILICONE applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this, please:

- Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover, and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- Using a separate clean, dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one self-adhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 and 2 if necessary.) Extra tabs have been provided.
- Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.

*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.

STEP 1. PREPARATIONS

- Put the headrests in their highest position.
 (Image A)
- Remove the cargo cover. It can be replaced later.
- Set the floor level to fit the specifications of your order.



STEP 2. INSTALLING THE BASE

 Place the Cargo liner in the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the underside attach directly to the carpet. (Image B)



STEP 3. INSTALLING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts.
 (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the Cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.



You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper part of the rear seats. (Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo.)






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STEP 4. INSTALLING THE SIDES

- On both sides of the cargo area stick the following loop fasteners in line with the hook fasteners sewn & welded on the reverse side of the cargo liner as highlighted on (Image E)
 - Blue 600 mm loop fastener
 - Green 400 mm loop fastener
- Snip the self-adhesive fastener strips at the corners to ease around the curve.
- On both sides, push the liner into the pockets (green arrow - image E)
- Fasten the hook fastener sewn and welded onto the top and back edge on both sides of the cargo liner directly onto the previously attached loop fasteners. (image E)








STEP 5. INSTALLING THE BACK

- Stick 2 x 400 mm loop fastener to the liftgate edge of the cargo area starting from the lock in the middle and running along the plastic panel (Image H).
- Stick 1 self-adhesive fastener tab to the inside center of the back panel, aligned with the hook fastener on the back panel of the cargo liner. (highlighted yellow- Image H)
- Attach the cargo liner to it using the hook fastener on the liner.



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OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Please note: not all of the photographs are specific to your vehicle.

STEP 6A. HEADREST COVER

- The Headrest cover is designed to protect the top of your rear seat giving additional protection from drooling dogs etc. (Image 1)
- Lower the headrests.
- Attach the Headrest cover to the loop fastener strip on the Cargo liner just below the top of the rear seats. (Image 2)
- Rear Plus / Split Cargo Liners ONLY
 The additional rectangle shaped section/s offer protection should you fold the seats (Image 3)




• Line up the Liftgate Cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)



Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.

STEP 6C. BUMPER FLAP

- Install the Cargo liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the Cargo liner. (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.











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STEP 6D. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection for the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option.

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus/Split version liner.
- It provides additional protection for the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection for the rear doors.
- Attach the Cargo Liner Extension to the main Cargo liner. (Image 6)
- Fasten the two ties in the corner together.
 (Orange arrows Image 7)
- Fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Blue arrows - image 7)

Please note: the Headrest Cover, Bumper Flap and Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

STEP 6E. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

• If you frequently remove/install your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will "fluff" up - we offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit. These tabs are placed between the Cargo liner and the cargo area carpet (Image 7+8)
